



Conditions of Membership

Conditions of Full, Assisted and Listed Membership

- a) Programs must submit their application; and
- b) A bank reference and an appropriate credit report, or a chartered Accountant's statement of solvency based on professionally prepared financial statements; or in the case of a public program, a statement of solvency from the institution's Chief Financial Officer.
- c) Programs must also provide documentation illustrating successful Accreditation by Languages Canada.
- d) Once these conditions have been satisfied, The Languages Canada Board will vote on the Full, Listed or Assisted Membership application.

To be considered for Associate Membership

- a) Applicants may submit their applications along with 2 references from current Languages Canada members.
- b) If an applicant cannot provide references from 2 current Languages Canada members, the applicant will, at its own expense, make a presentation to the board, giving details about its history, and its services, to explain why Languages Canada should accept it as an Associate Member.
- c) Once these conditions have been satisfied, The Languages Canada Board will vote on the Associate Membership application.
