






Languages Canada Fact Sheet 2017



The top source markets for BC are Japan, Brazil and Korea. These have been constant and fairly stable for the past five years.

Until 2015, Canada was a top source market, but a change in membership meant it did not appear in the top 10 for 2016.

Key Statistics

- 48,632 students in 2016
- 8 public sector, 48 private sector members
- \$485 million/yr in export income
- **1,893** employees (full- and part-time)
- **3,495** students in pathway programs, destined for further education in Canada
- 20% of students hold Study Permits

BC is the most attractive province to students from Japan: over 50% of Japanese students in Canada choose to study in the province
