

Turkey and Colombia, as well as Brazil, have been strong growing markets for Ontario.

Key Statistics

- 58,531 students in 2016
- 26 public sector, 62 private sector members
- \$618 million/yr in export income
- **2,897** employees (full- and part-time)
- 9,420 students in pathway programs, destined for further education in Canada
- 29% of students hold Study Permits

Over 40% of students in language programs study in Ontario.
