

Languages Canada Fact Sheet 2018





The overall number of students from Alberta increased slightly, as did the number of students from major markets.

The number of students from African countries has decreased for the second year in a row, though Africa remains a major source market for the province.

Key Statistics

- 10,209 students in 2017
- 13 public sector, 9 private sector members
- \$143 million/yr in export income
- 475 employees (full- and part-time)
- **922** students in pathway programs, destined for further education in Canada
- 24% of students hold Study Permits

Alberta programs welcome the highest proportion of students from Africa.
