

Brazil and Mexico continue to be strong and growing markets for Ontario programs.

## **Key Statistics**

- 66,076 students in 2017
- 26 public sector, 62 private sector members
- \$718 million/yr in export income
- 3,133 employees (full- and part-time)
- 9,943 students in pathway programs, destined for further education in Canada
- 31% of students hold Study Permits

Over 40% of students in language programs study in Ontario.
